* A new ISV Presidential Travel Award is established to fund 10 Presidential Awards of \$500 each to selected trainees who work in the field of vaccines. Candidates first must submit an abstract before the deadline (June 24, 2016). Awards will be chosen based upon evaluation by the Scientific Committee.

* The organizers of Vaccine Renaissance have traditionally provided funding to women or under-represented minority delegates to attend its conferences. This year Vaccine Renaissance X will continue to offer the same scholarship opportunities. Selected delegates will receive a \$250 to \$1,000 (USD) scholarship to be used to cover expenses related to attending Vaccine Renaissance X as part of the 2016 ISV Annual Congress (such as travel, lodging, and congress registration)

2016 ISV Annual Congress (www.ISVCongress.org <<http://www.ISVCongress.org>>) will be held in Boston, Massachusetts, United States on Oct. 2-4, 2016. International Society for Vaccines (ISV) (www.isv-online.org <<http://www.isv-online.org>>) is the global organization for vaccine professionals. ISV's Annual Congress is the world's largest non-commercial scientific conference in the field of vaccines to cover broad and balanced topics related to vaccines and immunotherapies

The Institute Pasteur, with its 33 institutes located throughout the world will join as a collaborator. National Research Council Canada is a partner for this year's Congress; Japanese Society for Vaccines, The Korean Vaccine Society and the newly formed ISV-China are also partners of 2016 ISV Annual Congress.

Two well-established specialty vaccine conferences will also join the 2016 ISV Annual Congress. Vaccine Renaissance X led by Dr. Annie De Groot and previously held annually in Providence, Rhode

Island, and the 2016 DNA Vaccine Conference led by Dr. David Weiner and held previously at various locations, will be organized as part of 2016 ISV Annual Congress program.
